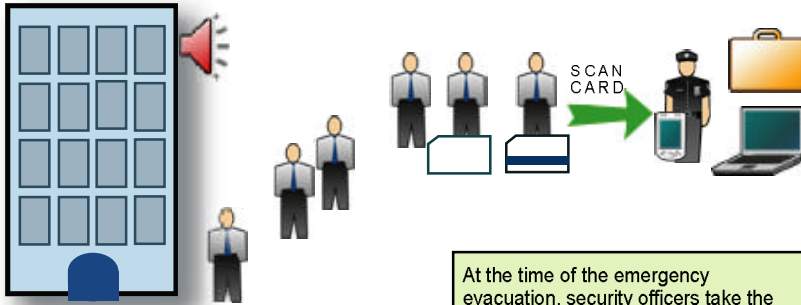

At the time of the emergency evacuation, security officers take the mustering kit with them to the mustering stations. They use the kits to check in and triage people who have safely evacuated the facility.

Rapid and accurate accounting of all personnel during an evacuation can mean the difference between life and death. The Enterprise Air mobile mustering kit is a comprehensive solution for effectively managing evacuations in emergency situations.

The mobile mustering kit is a self-contained computerized system designed to manage evacuations in real-time. By providing accurate and up-to-date data, it can direct rescue attempts and allow injured persons to receive aid more quickly.

## → Monitor Building Occupancy

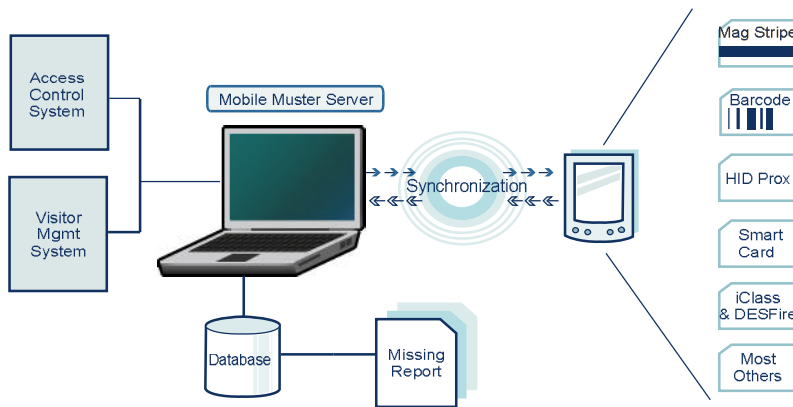
- Monitor access control and visitor systems to track building occupancy
- Automatically maintains evacuation check-in manifests
- Synchronize with most major access control systems
- Import data from files or spreadsheets, or manually enter data

## → Rapid Deployment to Assembly Points

- All components are stored in rugged kits with wheels
- Kits are integrated with power and networking for remote monitoring, synchronization, battery charging, and cooling
- Kits contain laptop-based servers, handheld check-in devices, printers, and networking equipment

## → Automate Check-In & Track Evacuation

- Immediately view number of potentially missing persons with breakdown by department, building or other criteria
- Scan badges with handheld computers to check in personnel
- Receive realtime updates from field regarding check-in progress at assembly points
